## **Prosperity**

**Deuteronomy 23:6** Thou shalt not seek their peace nor their prosperity all thy days for ever.

**1Samuel 25:6** And thus shall ye say to him that liveth *in prosperity*, Peace *be* both to thee, and peace *be* to thine house, and peace *be* unto all that thou hast.

**1Kings 10:7** Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen *it:* and, behold, the half was not told me: thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard.

**Job 15:21** A dreadful sound *is* in his ears: in prosperity the destroyer shall come upon him.

**Job 36:11** If they obey and serve *him,* they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.

**Psalms 30:6** And in my prosperity I said, I shall never be moved.

**Psalms 35:27** Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

**Psalms 73:3** For I was envious at the foolish, *when* I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

**Psalms 118:25** Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity.

**Psalms 122:7** Peace be within thy walls, *and* prosperity within thy palaces.

**Proverbs 1:32** For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them.

**Ecclesiastics 7:14** In the day of prosperity be joyful, but in the day of adversity consider: God also hath set the one over against the other, to the end that man should find nothing after him.

**Jeremiah 22:21** I spake unto thee in thy prosperity; *but* thou saidst, I will not hear. This *hath been* thy manner from thy youth, that thou obeyedst not my voice.

**Jeremiah 33:9** And it shall be to me a name of joy, a praise and an honour before all the nations of the earth, which shall hear all the good that I do unto them: and they

shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and for all the prosperity that I procure unto it.

**Lamentations 3:17** And thou hast removed my soul far off from peace: I forgat prosperity.

**Zechariah 1:17** Cry yet, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and the LORD shall yet comfort Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem.

**Zechariah 7:7** Should ye not hear the words which the LORD hath cried by the former prophets, when Jerusalem was inhabited and in prosperity, and the cities thereof round about her, when *men* inhabited the south and the plain?

**Genesis 24:40** And he said unto me, The LORD, before whom I walk, will send his angel with thee, and prosper thy way; and thou shalt take a wife for my son of my kindred, and of my father's house:

**Genesis 24:42** And I came this day unto the well, and said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, if now thou do prosper my way which I go:

**Genesis 39:3** And his master saw that the LORD *was* with him, and that the LORD made all that he did to prosper in his hand.

**Genesis 39:23** The keeper of the prison looked not to any thing *that was* under his hand; because the LORD was with him, and *that* which he did, the LORD made *it* to prosper.

**Numbers 14:41** And Moses said, Wherefore now do ye transgress the commandment of the LORD? but it shall not prosper.

**Deuteronomy 28:29** And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not **prosper** in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save *thee*.

**Deuteronomy 29:9** Keep therefore the words of this covenant, and do them, that ye may prosper in all that ye do.

**Joshua 1:7** Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it *to* the right hand or *to* the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

**1Kings 2:3** And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is

written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

**1Kings 22:12** And all the prophets prophesied so, saying, Go up to Ramothgilead, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver *it* into the king's hand.

**1Kings 22:15** So he came to the king. And the king said unto him, Micaiah, shall we go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall we forbear? And he answered him, Go, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver *it* into the hand of the king.

**1Chronicles 22:11** Now, my son, the LORD be with thee; and prosper thou, and build the house of the LORD thy God, as he hath said of thee.

**1Chronicles 22:13** Then shalt thou prosper, if thou takest heed to fulfil the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed.

**2Chronicles 13:12** And, behold, God himself *is* with us for *our* captain, and his priests with sounding trumpets to cry alarm against you. O children of Israel, fight ye not against the LORD God of your fathers; for ye shall not prosper.

**2Chronicles 18:11** And all the prophets prophesied so, saying, Go up to Ramothgilead, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver *it* into the hand of the king.

**2Chronicles 18:14** And when he was come to the king, the king said unto him, Micaiah, shall we go to Ramothgilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And he said, Go ye up, and prosper, and they shall be delivered into your hand.

**2Chronicles 20:20** And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.

**2Chronicles 24:20** And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you.

**2Chronicles 26:5** And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper.

**Nehemiah 1:11** O Lord, I beseech thee, let now thine ear be attentive to the prayer of thy servant, and to the prayer of thy servants, who desire to fear thy name: and

prosper, I pray thee, thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer.

**Nehemiah 2:20** Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore we his servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem.

**Job 12:6** The tabernacles of robbers prosper, and they that provoke God are secure; into whose hand God bringeth *abundantly*.

**Psalms 1:3** And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

**Psalms 73:12** Behold, these *are* the ungodly, who prosper in the world; they increase *in* riches.

**Psalms 122:6** Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.

**Proverbs 28:13** He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy.

**Ecclesiastics 11:6** In the morning sow thy seed, and in the evening withhold not thine hand: for thou knowest not whether shall prosper, either this or that, or whether they both *shall be* alike good.

**Isaiah 53:10** Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put *him* to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see *his* seed, he shall prolong *his* days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

**Isaiah 54:17** No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue *that* shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This *is* the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness *is* of me, saith the LORD.

**Isaiah 55:11** So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

**Jeremiah 2:37** Yea, thou shalt go forth from him, and thine hands upon thine head: for the LORD hath rejected thy confidences, and thou shalt not prosper in them.

**Jeremiah 5:28** They are waxen fat, they shine: yea, they overpass the deeds of the wicked: they judge not the cause, the cause of the fatherless, yet they prosper; and the right of the needy do they not judge.

**Jeremiah 10:21** For the pastors are become brutish, and have not sought the LORD: therefore they shall not prosper, and all their flocks shall be scattered.

**Jeremiah 12:1** Righteous *art* thou, O LORD, when I plead with thee: yet let me talk with thee of *thy* judgments: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? *wherefore* are all they happy that deal very treacherously?

**Jeremiah 20:11** But the LORD *is* with me as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: *their* everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten.

**Jeremiah 22:30** Thus saith the LORD, Write ye this man childless, a man *that* shall not prosper in his days: for no man of his seed shall prosper, sitting upon the throne of David, and ruling any more in Judah.

**Jeremiah 23:5** Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

**Jeremiah 32:5** And he shall lead Zedekiah to Babylon, and there shall he be until I visit him, saith the LORD: though ye fight with the Chaldeans, ye shall not prosper.

**Lamentations 1:5** Her adversaries are the chief, her enemies prosper; for the LORD hath afflicted her for the multitude of her transgressions: her children are gone into captivity before the enemy.

**Ezekiel 16:13** Thus wast thou decked with gold and silver; and thy raiment *was of* fine linen, and silk, and broidered work; thou didst eat fine flour, and honey, and oil: and thou wast exceeding beautiful, and thou didst prosper into a kingdom.

**Ezekiel 17:9** Say thou, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Shall it **prosper**? shall he not pull up the roots thereof, and cut off the fruit thereof, that it wither? it shall wither in all the leaves of her spring, even without great power or many people to pluck it up by the roots thereof.

**Ezekiel 17:10** Yea, behold, *being* planted, shall it **prosper**? shall it not utterly wither, when the east wind toucheth it? it shall wither in the furrows where it grew.

**Ezekiel 17:15** But he rebelled against him in sending his ambassadors into Egypt, that they might give him horses and much people. Shall he prosper? shall he escape that doeth such *things*? or shall he break the covenant, and be delivered?

**Daniel 8:24** And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people.

**Daniel 8:25** And through his policy also he shall cause craft to **prosper** in his hand; and he shall magnify *himself* in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but he shall be broken without hand.

**Daniel 11:27** And both these kings' hearts *shall be* to do mischief, and they shall speak lies at one table; but it shall not **prosper**: for yet the end *shall be* at the time appointed.

**Daniel 11:36** And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

**3John 1:2** Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.
