

Salvation

Genesis 49:18 I have waited for thy **salvation**, O LORD.

Exodus 14:13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the **salvation** of the LORD, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

Exodus 15:2 The LORD *is* my strength and song, and he is become my **salvation**: he *is* my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him.

Deuteronomy 32:15 But Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered *with fatness*; then he forsook God *which* made him, and lightly esteemed the Rock of his **salvation**.

1Samuel 2:1 And Hannah prayed, and said, My heart rejoiceth in the LORD, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in thy **salvation**.

1Samuel 11:13 And Saul said, There shall not a man be put to death this day: for to day the LORD hath wrought **salvation** in Israel.

1Samuel 14:45 And the people said unto Saul, Shall Jonathan die, who hath wrought this great **salvation** in Israel? God forbid: as the LORD liveth, there shall not one hair of his head fall to the ground; for he hath wrought with God this day. So the people rescued Jonathan, that he died not.

1Samuel 19:5 For he did put his life in his hand, and slew the Philistine, and the LORD wrought a great **salvation** for all Israel: thou sawest *it*, and didst rejoice: wherefore then wilt thou sin against innocent blood, to slay David without a cause?

2Samuel 22:3 The God of my rock; in him will I trust: *he is* my shield, and the horn of my **salvation**, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence.

2Samuel 22:36 Thou hast also given me the shield of thy **salvation**: and thy gentleness hath made me great.

2Samuel 22:47 The LORD liveth; and blessed *be* my rock; and exalted be the God of the rock of my **salvation**.

2Samuel 22:51 *He is the tower of salvation for his king: and sheweth mercy to his anointed, unto David, and to his seed for evermore.*

2Samuel 23:5 *Although my house be not so with God; yet he hath made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things, and sure: for this is all my salvation, and all my desire, although he make it not to grow.*

1Chronicles 16:23 *Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; shew forth from day to day his salvation.*

1Chronicles 16:35 *And say ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to thy holy name, and glory in thy praise.*

2Chronicles 6:41 *Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints rejoice in goodness.*

2Chronicles 20:17 *Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.*

Job 13:16 *He also shall be my salvation: for an hypocrite shall not come before him.*
Psalms 3:8 *Salvation belongeth unto the LORD: thy blessing is upon thy people. Selah.*

Psalms 9:14 *That I may shew forth all thy praise in the gates of the daughter of Zion: I will rejoice in thy salvation.*

Psalms 13:5 *But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation.*

Psalms 14:7 *Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad.*

Psalms 18:2 *The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower.*

Psalms 18:35 *Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great.*

Psalms 18:46 *The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock; and let the God of my salvation be exalted.*

Psalms 20:5 We will rejoice in thy **salvation**, and in the name of our God we will set up *our* banners: the LORD fulfil all thy petitions.

Psalms 21:1 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The king shall joy in thy strength, O LORD; and in thy **salvation** how greatly shall he rejoice!

Psalms 21:5 His glory *is* great in thy **salvation**: honour and majesty hast thou laid upon him.

Psalms 24:5 He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his **salvation**.

Psalms 25:5 Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou *art* the God of my **salvation**; on thee do I wait all the day.

Psalms 27:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD *is* my light and my **salvation**; whom shall I fear? the LORD *is* the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Psalms 27:9 Hide not thy face *far* from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my **salvation**.

Psalms 35:3 Draw out also the spear, and stop *the way* against them that persecute me: say unto my soul, I *am* thy **salvation**.

Psalms 35:9 And my soul shall be joyful in the LORD: it shall rejoice in his **salvation**.

Psalms 37:39 But the **salvation** of the righteous *is* of the LORD: *he is* their strength in the time of trouble.

Psalms 38:22 Make haste to help me, O Lord my **salvation**.

Psalms 40:10 I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy **salvation**: I have not concealed thy loving kindness and thy truth from the great congregation.

Psalms 40:16 Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee: let such as love thy **salvation** say continually, The LORD be magnified.

Psalms 50:23 Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth *his* conversation *aright* will I shew the **salvation** of God.

Psalms 51:12 Restore unto me the joy of thy **salvation**; and uphold me *with thy* free spirit.

Psalms 51:14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my **salvation**: *and* my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness.

Psalms 53:6 Oh that the **salvation** of Israel *were come* out of Zion! When God bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, *and* Israel shall be glad.

Psalms 62:1 **To the chief Musician, to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David.** Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him *cometh* my **salvation**.

Psalms 62:2 He only *is* my rock and my **salvation**; *he is* my defence; I shall not be greatly moved.

Psalms 62:6 He only *is* my rock and my **salvation**; *he is* my defence; I shall not be moved.

Psalms 62:7 In God *is* my **salvation** and my glory: the rock of my strength, *and* my refuge, *is* in God.

Psalms 65:5 *By* terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our **salvation**; *who art* the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off *upon* the sea:

Psalms 68:19 Blessed *be* the Lord, *who* daily loadeth us *with benefits*, even the God of our **salvation**. Selah.

Psalms 68:20 *He that is* our God *is* the God of **salvation**; and unto GOD the Lord *belong* the issues from death.

Psalms 69:13 But as for me, my prayer *is* unto thee, O LORD, *in* an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy **salvation**.

Psalms 69:29 But I *am* poor and sorrowful: let thy **salvation**, O God, set me up on high.

Psalms 70:4 Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee: and let such as love thy **salvation** say continually, Let God be magnified.

Psalms 71:15 My mouth shall shew forth thy righteousness *and* thy **salvation** all the day; for I know not the numbers *thereof*.

Psalms 74:12 For God *is* my King of old, working **salvation** in the midst of the earth.

Psalms 78:22 Because they believed not in God, and trusted not in his **salvation**:

Psalms 79:9 Help us, O God of our **salvation**, for the glory of thy name: and deliver us, and purge away our sins, for thy name's sake.

Psalms 85:4 Turn us, O God of our **salvation**, and cause thine anger toward us to cease.

Psalms 85:7 Shew us thy mercy, O LORD, and grant us thy **salvation**.

Psalms 85:9 Surely his **salvation** *is* nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.

Psalms 88:1 **A Song or Psalm for the sons of Korah, to the chief Musician upon Mahalath Leannoth, Maschil of Heman the Ezrahite.** O LORD God of my **salvation**, I have cried day *and* night before thee:

Psalms 89:26 He shall cry unto me, Thou *art* my father, my God, and the rock of my **salvation**.

Psalms 91:16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my **salvation**.

Psalms 95:1 O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our **salvation**.

Psalms 96:2 Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his **salvation** from day to day.

Psalms 98:2 The LORD hath made known his **salvation**: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen.

Psalms 98:3 He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the **salvation** of our God.

Psalms 106:4 Remember me, O LORD, with the favour *that thou bearest unto* thy people: O visit me with thy **salvation**;

Psalms 116:13 I will take the cup of **salvation**, and call upon the name of the LORD.

Psalms 118:14 The LORD *is* my strength and song, and is become my **salvation**.

Psalms 118:15 The voice of rejoicing and **salvation** *is* in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

Psalms 118:21 I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my **salvation**.

Psalms 119:41 VAU. Let thy mercies come also unto me, O LORD, *even thy salvation*, according to thy word.

Psalms 119:81 CAPH. My soul fainteth for thy *salvation*: *but* I hope in thy word.

Psalms 119:123 Mine eyes fail for thy *salvation*, and for the word of thy righteousness.

Psalms 119:155 *Salvation* *is* far from the wicked: for they seek not thy statutes.

Psalms 119:166 LORD, I have hoped for thy *salvation*, and done thy commandments.

Psalms 119:174 I have longed for thy *salvation*, O LORD; and thy law *is* my delight.

Psalms 132:16 I will also clothe her priests with *salvation*: and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.

Psalms 140:7 O GOD the Lord, the strength of my *salvation*, thou hast covered my head in the day of battle.

Psalms 144:10 *It is he* that giveth *salvation* unto kings: who delivereth David his servant from the hurtful sword.

Psalms 149:4 For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with *salvation*.

Isaiah 12:2 Behold, God *is* my *salvation*; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH *is* my strength and *my* song; he also *is* become my *salvation*.

Isaiah 12:3 Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of *salvation*.

Isaiah 17:10 Because thou hast forgotten the God of thy *salvation*, and hast not been mindful of the rock of thy strength, therefore shalt thou plant pleasant plants, and shalt set it with strange slips:

Isaiah 25:9 And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this *is* our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us: this *is* the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his *salvation*.

Isaiah 26:1 In that day shall this song be sung in the land of Judah; We have a strong city; *salvation* will *God* appoint *for* walls and bulwarks.

Isaiah 33:2 O LORD, be gracious unto us; we have waited for thee: be thou their arm every morning, our *salvation* also in the time of trouble.

Isaiah 33:6 And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, *and* strength of **salvation**: the fear of the LORD *is* his treasure.

Isaiah 45:8 Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness: let the earth open, and let them bring forth **salvation**, and let righteousness spring up together; I the LORD have created it.

Isaiah 45:17 *But* Israel shall be saved in the LORD with an everlasting **salvation**: ye shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end.

Isaiah 46:13 I bring near my righteousness; it shall not be far off, and my **salvation** shall not tarry: and I will place **salvation** in Zion for Israel my glory.

Isaiah 49:6 And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my **salvation** unto the end of the earth.

Isaiah 49:8 Thus saith the LORD, In an acceptable time have I heard thee, and in a day of **salvation** have I helped thee: and I will preserve thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages;

Isaiah 51:5 My righteousness *is* near; my **salvation** is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust.

Isaiah 51:6 Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my **salvation** shall be for ever, and my righteousness shall not be abolished.

Isaiah 51:8 For the moth shall eat them up like a garment, and the worm shall eat them like wool: but my righteousness shall be for ever, and my **salvation** from generation to generation.

Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth **salvation**; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth!

Isaiah 52:10 The LORD hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the **salvation** of our God.

Isaiah 56:1 Thus saith the LORD, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my **salvation** *is* near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

Isaiah 59:11 We roar all like bears, and mourn sore like doves: we look for judgment, but *there is* none; for **salvation**, *but* it is far off from us.

Isaiah 59:16 And he saw that *there was* no man, and wondered that *there was* no intercessor: therefore his arm brought **salvation** unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him.

Isaiah 59:17 For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of **salvation** upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance *for* clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloke.

Isaiah 60:18 Violence shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls **Salvation**, and thy gates Praise.

Isaiah 61:10 I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of **salvation**, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh *himself* with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth *herself* with her jewels.

Isaiah 62:1 For Zion's sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the righteousness thereof go forth as brightness, and the **salvation** thereof as a lamp *that* burneth.

Isaiah 62:11 Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy **salvation** cometh; behold, his reward *is* with him, and his work before him.

Isaiah 63:5 And I looked, and *there was* none to help; and I wondered that *there was* none to uphold: therefore mine own arm brought **salvation** unto me; and my fury, it upheld me.

Jeremiah 3:23 Truly in vain is **salvation** *hoped for* from the hills, *and from* the multitude of mountains: truly in the LORD our God *is* the **salvation** of Israel.

Lamentations 3:26 *It is* good that a *man* should both hope and quietly wait for the **salvation** of the LORD.

Jonah 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay *that* that I have vowed. **Salvation** *is* of the LORD.

Micah 7:7 Therefore I will look unto the LORD; I will wait for the God of my **salvation**: my God will hear me.

Habakkuk 3:8 Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? *was* thine anger against the rivers? *was* thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst ride upon thine horses *and* thy chariots of **salvation**?

Habakkuk 3:13 Thou wentest forth for the **salvation** of thy people, *even* for **salvation** with thine anointed; thou woundedst the head out of the house of the wicked, by discovering the foundation unto the neck. Selah.

Habakkuk 3:18 Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my **salvation**.

Zechariah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he *is* just, and having **salvation**; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Luke 1:69 And hath raised up an horn of **salvation** for us in the house of his servant David;

Luke 1:77 To give knowledge of **salvation** unto his people by the remission of their sins,

Luke 2:30 For mine eyes have seen thy **salvation**,

Luke 3:6 And all flesh shall see the **salvation** of God.

Luke 19:9 And Jesus said unto him, This day is **salvation** come to this house, forso much as he also is a son of Abraham.

John 4:22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for **salvation** is of the Jews.

Acts 4:12 Neither is there **salvation** in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Acts 13:26 Men *and* brethren, children of the stock of Abraham, and whosoever among you feareth God, to you is the word of this **salvation** sent.

Acts 13:47 For so hath the Lord commanded us, *saying*, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldst be for **salvation** unto the ends of the earth.

Acts 16:17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of **salvation**.

Acts 28:28 Be it known therefore unto you, that the **salvation** of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and *that* they will hear it.

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto **salvation** to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Romans 10:10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto **salvation**.

Romans 11:11 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but *rather* through their fall **salvation** *is come* unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy.

Romans 13:11 And that, knowing the time, that now *it is* high time to awake out of sleep: for now *is* our **salvation** nearer than when we believed.

2Corinthians 1:6 And whether we be afflicted, *it is* for your consolation and **salvation**, which is effectual in the enduring of the same sufferings which we also suffer: or whether we be comforted, *it is* for your consolation and **salvation**.

2Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of **salvation** have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of **salvation**.)

2Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to **salvation** not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.

Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also *trusted*, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your **salvation**: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

Ephesians 6:17 And take the helmet of **salvation**, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Philippians 1:19 For I know that this shall turn to my **salvation** through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ,

Philippians 1:28 And in nothing terrified by your adversaries: which is to them an evident token of perdition, but to you of **salvation**, and that of God.

Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own **salvation** with fear and trembling.

1Thessalonians 5:8 But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of **salvation**.

1Thessalonians 5:9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain **salvation** by our Lord Jesus Christ,

2Thessalonians 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to **salvation** through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

2Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the **salvation** which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

2Timothy 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto **salvation** through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God that bringeth **salvation** hath appeared to all men,

Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of **salvation**?

Hebrews 2:3 How shall we escape, if we neglect so great **salvation**; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard *him*;

Hebrews 2:10 For it became him, for whom *are* all things, and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their **salvation** perfect through sufferings.

Hebrews 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal **salvation** unto all them that obey him;

Hebrews 6:9 But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany **salvation**, though we thus speak.

Hebrews 9:28 So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto **salvation**.

1Peter 1:5 Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto **salvation** ready to be revealed in the last time.

1Peter 1:9 Receiving the end of your faith, *even* the **salvation** of *your* souls.

1Peter 1:10 Of which **salvation** the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the *grace that should come* unto you:

2Peter 3:15 And account *that* the longsuffering of our Lord *is* salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;

Jude 1:3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort *you* that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

Revelation 7:10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Revelation 19:1 And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:
