June - Juno - Wife of Jupiter. Queen of the gods- Childbirth and Marriage

July - Julius Ceasar - Was the fifth month

August - Augustus Ceasar - Was the six month

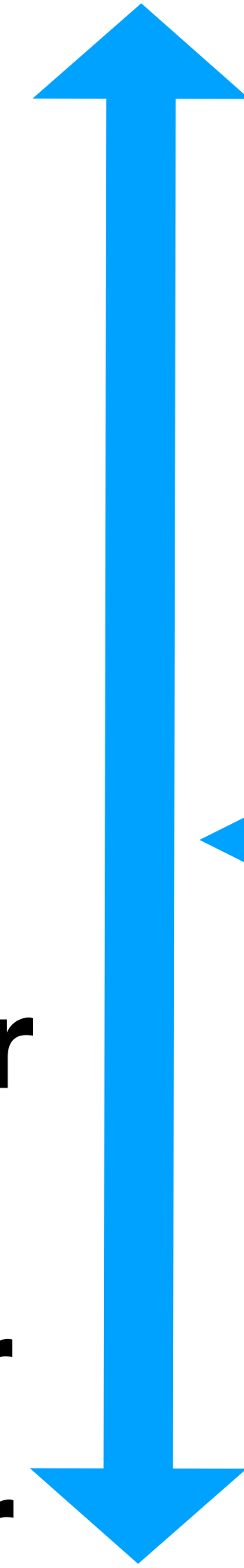
