The Sign of Jonah

<u>Matthew 12:38</u> Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.

<u>Matthew 12:39</u> But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas:

A Great Fish Swallows Jonah

Jonah 1:17 Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

<u>Jonah 2:9</u> But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay *that* that I have vowed. Salvation *is* of the LORD.

<u>Jonah 2:10</u> And the LORD spake unto the fish, and it vomited out Jonah upon the dry land.

The Lord Jesus tells the Pharisee's how He will save the world and in that how the Kingdom will advance.

Struggle should place the one struggling in a place where it appears that all hope is lost and there is no way out!

The Fish Belly or the Tomb!

Question, when did Jesus rise from the dead?

I submit that it was as soon as they rolled the stone in place. He didn't teach those in Abraham's bosom in spirit only but in body also!

I also know that Jesus' communication with the FATHER was one of complete gratefulness and praise!

Because this was the way Jonah was released from the fish's belly!

Here is your release from everything that holds you!!

Thanksgiving

Yada - H3034

The KJV translates Strong's H3034 in the following manner: praise (53x), give thanks (32x), confess (16x), thank (5x), make confession (2x), thanksgiving (2x), cast (1x), cast out (1x), shoot (1x), thankful (1x).

Eucharisteō – G2168

The KJV translates Strong's G2168 in the following manner: give thanks (26x), thank (12x), be thankful (1x).

- <u>1 Thessalonians 5:18</u> In <u>every thing</u> give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- **<u>2 Samuel 22:50</u>** Therefore I will give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and I will sing praises unto thy name.

<u>Luke 2:38</u> And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem.

Luke 17:16 And fell down on *his* face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan.

- <u>Luke 22:17</u> And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, <u>Take this</u>, and <u>divide</u> *it* among yourselves:
- <u>Luke 22:19</u> And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- <u>John 6:11</u> And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.
- <u>John 6:23</u> (Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:)
- <u>Acts 27:35</u> And when he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken *it*, he began to eat.
- <u>Romans 14:6</u> He that regardeth the day, regardeth *it* unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard *it*. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.
- <u>Romans 16:4</u> Who have for my life laid down their own necks: unto whom not only I give thanks, but also all the churches of the Gentiles.
- <u>1 Corinthians 10:30</u> For if I by grace be a partaker, why am I evil spoken of for that for which I give thanks?
- <u>1 Corinthians 11:24</u> And when he had given thanks, he brake *it*, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- <u>1 Corinthians 14:16</u> Else when thou shalt bless with the spirit, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest?
- **1 Corinthians 14:17** For thou verily givest thanks well, but the other is not edified.
- **1 Corinthians 15:57** But thanks *be* to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- **2 Corinthians 1:11** Ye also helping together by prayer for us, that for the gift bestowed upon us by the means of many persons thanks may be given by many on our behalf.

- <u>2 Corinthians 2:14</u> Now thanks *be* unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.
- <u>2 Corinthians 8:16</u> But thanks *be* to God, which put the same earnest care into the heart of Titus for you.
- **2 Corinthians 9:15** Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift.
- **Ephesians 1:16** Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers;
- **Ephesians 5:4** Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.
- **Ephesians 5:20** Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;
- <u>Colossians 1:3</u> We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,

The Second Weapon

The Mind and Thoughts

<u>Proverbs 23:7</u> For as he thinketh in his heart, so *is* he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart *is* not with thee.

As believers we must change the way we think!

The reason has to do with living in a fallen world, but function like we are in heaven.

EVERYTHING here is designed to shape thought and to bring us into a drafting relationship with God and each other!

The Word of God is the primary way to bring the mind and thoughts under the control of the Lord! But we must also make some determinations about the way we want to live as well!

So, that we will not be fighting internal battles!

<u>Galatians 5:17</u> For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

<u>Matthew 22:37</u> Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

<u>Mark 12:30</u> And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this *is* the first commandment.

Ephesians 2:3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

Ephesians 4:17 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,

Ephesians 4:23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

Romans 7:23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the **law of my mind**, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

<u>Romans 7:25 I</u> thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

<u>Romans 8:5</u> For they that are after the **flesh do mind the things of the flesh**; but they that are after the Spirit <u>do mind</u> the things of the Spirit.

<u>Romans 8:7</u> Because the carnal mind *is* enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Romans 8:27 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what *is* the **mind of the Spirit**, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of* God.

<u>Romans 12:2</u> And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Romans 12:16 Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

Romans 15:6 That ye may with one mind *and* one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>Romans 15:15</u> Nevertheless, brethren, I have written the more boldly unto you in some sort, as putting you in mind, because of the grace that is given to me of God,

<u>1 Corinthians 1:10</u> Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and *that* there be no divisions among you; but *that* ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

Someone may tell you that you look like a relative or they may say you Acts like a relative!

The fact that a person Acts like another person mean they also think like the person also.

The image is the dust being formed into a man, the likeness if the breath breathed into that form and a living Soul was created.

At that moment man had the ability to think, determine and feel like God!

He could name the animals because he thought just like the Godhead would think!

Philippians 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

<u>Luke 9:25</u> For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away?

It is a person soul that have the ability to thrive without the help from God!

Many have tapped into the understanding on how use their souls through hours of isolation and concentration to produce what they desire in the earth!

But now, outside of the covering of God the enemy will aide a person to function in this ability to keep them from truly finding a relationship with Jesus!

Mind over Matter! The Body will obey the mind when a person learn how to **focus** the mind to accomplish unusual feats!

Monks do various feats with their bodies that defy nature. What does it take to do these things?

The first thing we will say as believers in Christ is that it is the devil! And it could be, but it could also be their ability to control their minds!

But it takes complete focus!

- They Aren't watching TV
- They don't play video game
- They don't spend time shopping
- They aren't on the golf course
- They aren't marrying and having children

Just to name a few!

Now many things in the sited list isn't necessarily bad they still take away time and focus from the things of Heaven.

Adam would have used all of this ability without any interference from hell if he hadn't disobeyed the Godhead.

So what would we look like if our attention was set daily for hours seeking after the Lord?

Not in a random fashion, but in a way that would help us accomplish heavenly solutions on the earth!

Breakthrough requires focused thought! True Mediation

<u>Psalms 118:21</u> I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation.

<u>Psalms 118:22</u> The stone which the builders refused is become the head stone of the corner.

<u>Psalms 118:23</u> This is the LORD'S doing; it is marvellous in our eyes.

<u>Psalms 118:24</u> This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.

<u>Psalms 118:25</u> Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity.

The Authority

The Great Commission

<u>Matthew 28:16</u> Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Jesus had appointed them.

<u>Matthew 28:17</u> And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted.

<u>Matthew 28:18</u> And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

<u>Matthew 28:19</u> Go ye therefore, and <u>teach</u> <u>all nations</u>, <u>baptizing them</u> in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

<u>Matthew 28:20</u> <u>Teaching</u> them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen.

Revisit Genesis Chapter One

<u>Genesis 1:26</u> And God said, Let us make man in **our image**, after **our likeness:** and **let them have dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

<u>Genesis 1:27</u> So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

<u>Genesis 1:28</u> And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, **and subdue it**: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

<u>Romans 8:18</u> For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time (The Struggle) are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. (The Breakthrough)

<u>Romans 8:19</u> For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for <u>the</u> <u>manifestation</u> of the sons of God. This verse tells us that the sons of God will be seen! And just seen but able to function in the abilities that God designed from the beginning!

FATHER has never changed His mind about what was established in the beginning!

Write down what would you look like when walking in this earth as a son of God!

Romans 8:20 For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected *the same* in hope, What was the hope? That man would embrace the salvation plan and return back to a divine relationship!

Romans 8:21 Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

Romans 8:22 For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now.

What will the trees and plant life look like when released from corruption!

Romans 8:23 And not only *they,* but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, *to wit,* the redemption of our body.

When we realize that this planet is not our home then we will become restless inside and start desiring our real home.

We will not want to leave our assignment unfinished, but like the Apostle Paul be thrown between starting here and leaving for home!

I submit we must finish our work with our eyes looking towards heaven. Therefore we will do everything unto the Lord for the advancement of the Kingdom!

This way we can work here without the frustration of missing our true home!

Romans 8:24 For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?

Romans 8:25 But if we hope for that we see not, *then* do we with patience wait for *it*.

Increase Your Hope!

<u>Romans 8:26</u> Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

It is time for us allow the Holy Spirit to do the work HE was sent here to do!

Invite HIM to pray you through the time of Struggle and Gap experience, so that you can experience the breakthrough!

Begin to have a regular ongoing conversation with Holy Spirit about everything you are doing!

<u>Acts 15:28</u> For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things;

Romans 8:27 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what *is* the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of* God.

The will of GOD isn't always apparent to us as we move throughout the earth! But the Holy Spirit know the will and prays it for us!

It is not magic that we experience but a designed plan taking shape! The next verse is the work of Holy Spirit and not chance!

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose.

Here is the entire design!

Romans 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate *to be* conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Romans 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

From an authoritative position we must speak and think! Understanding we have heavenly, Godly help to accomplish any and all task!

The Fourth Weapon

Faith

<u>Hebrews 11:1</u> Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

<u>Hebrews 11:2</u> For by it the elders obtained a good report.

Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from <u>faith to faith</u>: as it is written, **The just shall live by faith**.

<u>Galatians 3:11</u> But that no man is justified by <u>the law</u> in the sight of God, it is evident: for, **The just shall live by faith**.

<u>Hebrews 10:38</u> Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man <u>draw back</u>, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

We must learn to operate in racial faith! Everything and everyone in heaven functions in faith!

Because everyone want to and does please God!

<u>Hebrews 11:6</u> But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

<u>Matthew 17:19</u> Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?

<u>Matthew 17:20</u> And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If <u>ye have faith</u> as a <u>grain of mustard seed</u>, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

<u>Matthew 17:21</u> Howbeit this kind <u>(Unbelief)</u> goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.

<u>Matthew 21:21</u> Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If **ye** have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.

Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

Mark 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Mark 11:25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

<u>Mark 11:26</u> But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

<u>Luke 7:9</u> When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

Luke 7:50 And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

<u>Luke 8:48</u> And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.
